Ambitious plans at Soulyale

Working with the local community, we have developed ambitious plans for school growth at Soulyale School, a rural community in the north west of Burkina Faso.

To cope with the increasing numbers of pupils, we are aiming to support the school with new classrooms and other buildings, as well as providing other equipment such as school furniture and solar panels.

The school also plans a major tree planting scheme around the site, which will improve the local soil and environment, as well as providing shade for students during the heat of the day.

Did you know that Ouagadougou will shortly host Africa's biggest film festival?

FESPACO is a biannual event, which sees hundreds of African made films showcased. To accommodate everyone that wants to come, the opening night is held in the national football stadium!

The next FESPACO festival is due to take place in March 2017, part of a vibrant but little known film industry in Burkina Faso

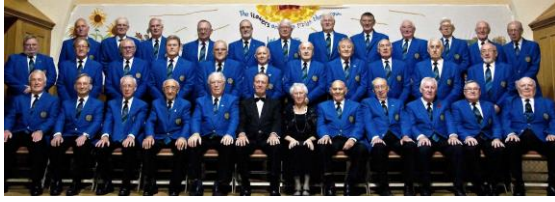


Starting well

Each week, over a hundred women come to our Bethanie medical centre for ante and post natal clinics.

Serving a fast growing community of over 120,000 people on the outskirts of the capital, Ouagadougou; the centre plays a vital role in offering neo natal and maternity services to the predominantly young local population.

We aim to support this work by updating the centre's maternity equipment and offering further training for their midwives.



Sewing and singing - and raising funds for our work
